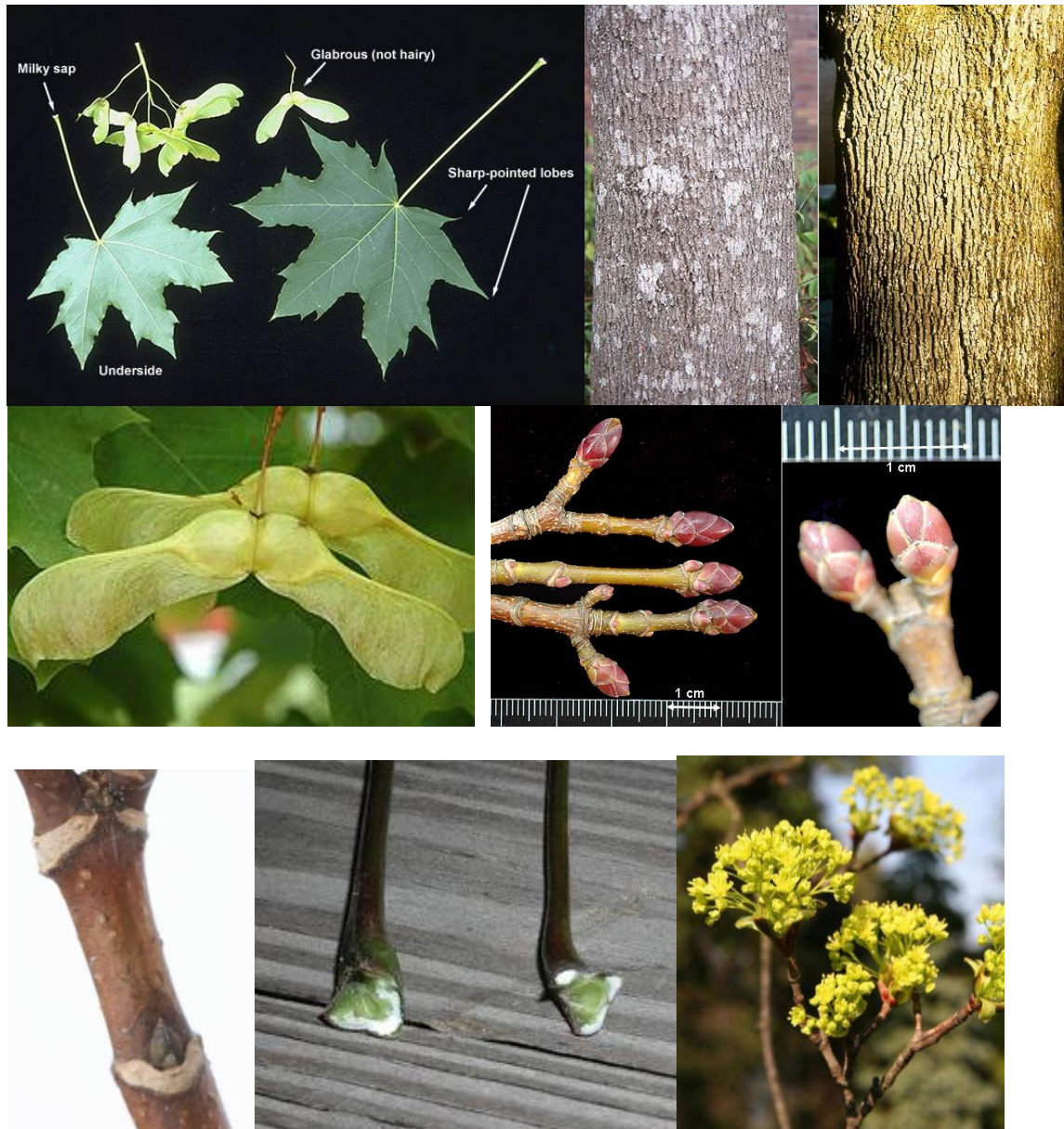


Bigleaf Maple



- Where is it located (i.e. street tree, part of our region, forest, etc)? And what's its age?
- Bigleaf Maple has rough bark with longitudinal ridges
- Bark often covered in epiphytes (i.e. moss, lichen, licorice fern, etc)
- "V" shaped leaf scar
- Milky sap
- Long flower panicles/racemes
- 1 ½ to 2 in samara with acute angle

Norway Maple



- Buds are large (1/4 inch) and red or greenish-red with two to three pairs of bud scales; they are a sure means of identification in the winter. Buds are rounded rather than acute-tipped.
- Milky sap
- Many cultivars
- Pointed lobes
- Samara; larger; wide angle; like a mustache
- Gray-brown furrowed bark
