
Bigleaf Maple

Norway Maple



- Buds are large (1/4 inch) and red or greenish-red with two to three pairs of bud scales; they are a • sure means of identification in the winter. Buds are rounded rather than acute-tipped.

- Samara; larger; wide angle; like a mustache Gray-brown furrowed bark •
