On behalf of our two organizations, Columbia Land Trust and Bird Alliance of Oregon, Backyard Habitat wants to thank you for joining the thousands of other yards and greenspaces in our region working to restore native Willamette Valley habitat and create a healthier region for wildlife, people, and communities.

### How The Process Works

1. You just received your initial site visit with a Backyard Habitat Technician, an important first step.
2. Over the next week, your Technician will email you a site report with recommendations and the next steps for implementing your habitat goals.
3. At your own pace, you'll start implementing the recommendations your Technician shared.
4. Use our website, coupons, handouts, and other resources to deepen your knowledge and improve your habitat. We'll check in every 6-9 months via phone or email.
5. When you're ready to certify your habitat\*, let us know, whether that's in six months or six years!
6. Certifications are valid for three years. The renewal process is easy (online) and free.

Working together, we're creating a region that provides places where birds can nest, bees can pollinate, and native plants and humans can thrive. Thank you.
